2023 Daylesford Wine Show - Conditions of Entry

- 1. **Eligibility:** Entry will be restricted to wine made from fruit grown (85%) in the Macedon Ranges and surrounding Wine Regions and the areas in between, i.e. Bendigo, Heathcote, Kilmore, Sunbury and Ballarat.

- 2. Entry fees \$25 per entry: No rebate of fees for withdrawn exhibits will be made.
- 3. All entries must be on the form provided.
- 4. Each entry consists of two (2) x750ml bottled wine or equivalent.
- 5. Exhibitors may enter as many entries as they choose in all classes.
- 6. Each bottle must carry the Daylesford Wine Show label. However, you do not need to remove your own labels.
- 7. Entries of **blended wines** must represent the prescribed quantities of each grape variety on the entry forms.
- 8. Wines entered must be available for purchase at your cellar door or other outlet.
- 9. Trophy or top medal winners undertake to supply one case free if required for the Awards Dinner following Wine Judging. In return you will be entitled to receive a case of mixed surplus show wines. This does not apply to the Past Presidents Trophy where two bottles will be required for the sponsor.
- 10. Wines eligible for the Past Presidents Trophy for the best aged wine (6+ years) red or white will be in a separate class (Class M) this year. The winner needs only provide 2 extra bottles. A wine cannot win this trophy twice.
- 11. Julian West Trophy (encouragement award) is awarded on the basis of the highest scoring 3 wines from a winery producing less than 25 tonnes per year whose owner makes the wine, provided that the winery has not won a trophy in any class.
- 12. Exhibits will be judged on points.
- 13. Lilian Carter of Vinemark will be the Chair this year. Judges are:
 - Lilian Carter VineMark Chair Judge
 - Narelle King Tar & Roses, Heathcote
 - Mark Hichin Wine x Sam, Seymour
- 14. All exhibits become the property of the Daylesford Wine Show Inc. society.
- 15. Exhibits must be delivered in containers properly marked to show **Exhibitors Name**. If more than 1 entry in a class. Please mark entry **Exhibit No 1, 2,** etc.
- 16. Daylesford Wine Show Inc. adheres to the Winemakers Federation of Australia Code of Practice for the Display of Awards.
- 17. Daylesford Wine Show Inc. is a member of the Australian Society of Viticulture and Oenology and we support the principles and guidelines of the ASVO for organising and conducting wine shows.
